





Installation is easier if the vehicle is clean and free of debris. For your safety, and to ensure a satisfactory installation, perform all installation steps correctly in the sequence shown.

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS


- Remove and discard the two original machine screws (A) retaining the upper plastic piece.
- 2. Remove and keep the two original machine screws (B) retaining the bottom plastic piece.
 - a. If a winch is installed: those screws will be used at Step 4.
 - b. If no winch is installed: those screws will not be used for this bumper's installation but have to be kept if a winch is installed in the future.




3. Place and fix the front bumper bracket (5) to the vehicle using two M8 x 100 mm screws (1). Tighten the bolts.



4. If your Sportman XP have a front integrated winch, place the bumper (4) using two M8 x 20 mm screws (2) supplied with the kit and the screws kept in Step 2 (B) (screw the first threads only). Don't use the two M8 x 80 mm (3) provided with the kit.



If your Sportman XP doesn't have a front integrated winch place the bumper (4) using two M8 x 20 mm screws (2) and the spacers (6) with the two M8 x 80 mm bolts (3) to attach the lower bracket of the bumper to the vehicle (screw the first threads only).



5. Tighten all bolts and nuts from the top of the bumper to the bottom.
